The Clippers don't use the blackout crowd lighting that the Lakers use, which creates a much different shooting background. Since 2009-10, LAL is 5-0 SU and 3-2 ATS when it is the home team in this matchup, but the Clippers are 4-1 SU and 5-0 ATS when they host. The Lakers have shot just 41.3% FG (31% threes) in the five most recent times they "visited" the Clippers.
