Boston's road struggles continued on Sunday, as they blew a five-point lead in the final three minutes of a 97-94 loss to the Lakers. The Celtics have dropped seven of eight road games SU, though they did cover Sunday, snapping an eight-game ATS road losing streak. But Boston is just 3-8 ATS in the second part of back-to-backs this year and haven't covered on the road against L.A.'s other team since 2008. The Clippers are 11-4 ATS after an SU loss.
