**GAME BREAKDOWN:** The Super Bowl champions are back with plenty of offensive firepower between QB Eli Manning, WR Victor Cruz, a healthy WR Hakeem Nicks and rookie RB David Wilson joining RB Ahmad Bradshaw in the backfield. They're once again thin in the secondary with starting CB Terrell Thomas going down for the year again, but they have the dominating pass rush to make up for it. After being torched by Manning and Co. a year ago, the Cowboys added free agent CB Brandon Carr and first-round pick CB Morris Claiborne to their weak secondary. Of course, this will likely come down to Tony Romo limiting mistakes.

**GAME BREAKDOWN:** The Colts start the Andrew Luck era with optimism after a strong preseason. But even if their offense is clicking, their defense is a huge question mark. They're switching to a 3-4 defense with 4-3 personnel (and they weren't a very good defense as a 4-3). The Bears were 7-3 SU last year before Jay Cutler and Matt Forte got injured, and their offense has improved with the acquisition of old Cutler favorite WR Brandon Marshall. Their bend-don't-break Cover-2 defense should be solid again, especially with DE Julius Peppers anchoring the pass rush.

**GAME BREAKDOWN:** After ending the season with four-straight win-and-covers, the Eagles are a popular pick to bounce-back from a disappointing 2011 campaign. WR DeSean Jackson is finally happy with his contract and WR Jeremy Maclin is over last year's cancer scare, so QB Michael Vick's unit should again be explosive (after a couple preseason scares, Vick enters the season healthy). Philly's pass rush is elite and they're hoping LB DeMeco Ryans will sure up a shaky LB unit. Cleveland is relying on rookie QB Brandon Weeden to perform right away. RB Trent Richardson is likely to be limited with knee problems.

**GAME BREAKDOWN:** Buffalo spent big to improve their weak front seven, adding free agent DEs Mario Williams and Mark Anderson to go along with DT Kyle Williams and emerging star DT Marcell Dareus. Chan Gailey's smoke-and-mirrors offense will likely be able to move the ball sporadically. The Jets struggled to stop the run last year and are still looking for a pass rush, but the Darrelle Revis factor gives them a huge edge again. The offense will return to "ground-and-pound" under new OC Tony Sparano, but they looked awful in the preseason (one touchdown). They may have some Tim Tebow tricks up their sleeve.

**GAME BREAKDOWN:** The Redskins ushered in the RG3 era with dual threat rookie Robert Griffin III looking to spark a listless offense. He'll have his hands full against an aggressive Saints defense. The 'Skins are also still looking for answers on the offensive line and the secondary. Though Sean Payton is suspended for the season, the Saints should be fine on offense with Drew Brees running the show. They added numerous new LBs over the offseason, but new starters Curtis Lofton and David Hawthorne are working their way back from preseason injuries. Their run defense is once again a question mark.

Dave is known to step out and pick games that are not on the national radar, and he nailed the Texas San Antonio's debut in FBS this past Saturday, taking the Roadrunners at +6.5 versus South Alabama, and enjoying the outright 33-31 win for the underdog.

**StatFox Gary**

StatFox Gary joined the StatFox and Platinum Sheet staff prior to the 2010 football season, and subscribers were certainly happy he did: He proceeded to post a 55% success rate on NFL Best Bets in his "rookie" season. Gary also has a knack for college over/unders, finishing the bowl season 4-1 in his Best Bet totals. He nailed two of his three college football ATS Best Bets with underdogs Boise State and Vanderbilt both covering in nationally televised games.
