StatFox Dave

StatFox Dave is one of the original four founders of StatFox and over the years has been renowned for his handicapping prowess in all sports. Dave is coming off two monster weeks for NFL Best Bets, posting a 78% ATS mark since Week 3. That improves him to 58% ATS (11-8) for the season in NFL Best Bets. He is also 23-8-1 ATS (74%) in all of his CFB grid games during the past 2 weeks.

StatFox Gary

StatFox Gary joined the StatFox and the Platinum Sheet staff prior to the 2010 football season. where he posted a 55% success rate on NFL Best Bets in his "rookie" season. Gary remained profitable in 2013 with a 67% ATS (16-8) success rate in NFL Best Bets after Week 9 and 57% ATS in CBB Best Bets. This season, Garv is 71% in his NFL Totals, going a perfect 3-0 in Week 4.

StatFox Scott

StatEox Scott serves as Managing Editor for StatFox, Platinum Sheet and the Edge Football Preview Guide, and known for strong finishes. Last vear. he was 59% ATS (33-23) in NFL Best Bets after Week 3, and was 56% (40-31) for yearly NFL Totals. He then went 64% ATS (25-14) in CBB Best Bets after Feb. 14. In the past two NFL weeks, Scott is 76% ATS in all picks and 88% ATS in Best Bets.

StatFox Brian

A featured writer on Stat-Fox.com and for Platinum Sheet, StatFox Brian has vet to suffer a losing pro or college football season of Platinum Sheet Best Bets since coming on board in 2010. Last year he tallied an impressive 60% ATS mark (41-27) in NFL Best Bets and insane 69% ATS record (76-34) in CBB Best Bets. Brian is 68% ATS (27-13-2) in NFL Best Bets since 11/25 and 10-2 in NFL Totals in 2014.

GAME BREAKDOWN: The Jaguars fell to 0-4 both SU & ATS after a 33-14 loss at San Diego on Sunday. It's the fourth straight season that Jacksonville has gotten off to a terrible start: The Jags went 1-4 SU & ATS over their first five games of 2011, 1-4 SU & 1-3-1 ATS to begin 2012, and 0-5 both SU & ATS to start 2013. GAME BREAKDOWN: The Ravens defeated the Panthers 38-10 on Sunday, piling up 454 total yards in the process. The Colts also blew out their opponent, beating the Titans 41-17 at home thanks to 393 yards and four touchdowns from Andrew Luck. The last five meetings between the Colts and Ravens have gone Under the total. They last met in a playoff game on January 6, 2013, when the Ravens won 24-9 in Baltimore. Luck threw for 288 yards in that game but was unable to find the end zone and threw an interception. GAME BREAKDOWN: Turnovers were the primary reason for the Bears' home loss to the Packers in Week 4-quarterback Jay Cutler threw a pair of interceptions as Chicago lost 38-17 despite outgaining Green Bay, 496 to 358, and possessing the ball for more than 36 minutes. StatFox Gary

StatFox Dave is one of the original four founders of StatFox and over the vears has been renowned for his handicapping prowess in all sports. Dave was especially strong in the college sports last season, posting a 55% ATS mark (38-31-2) in 2013 CFB Best Bets. This included a hefty 77% ATS record (17-5-1) on college football games that were not part of the marquee games grid above. Dave then went on to nail 62% ATS (70-43-2) in college basketball Best Bets. Dave is 58% ATS (11-8) in NFL Best Bets in 2014, and was 12-3-1 ATS in CFB marguee grid games last week.

StatFox Gary joined the StatFox and the Platinum Sheet staff prior to the 2010 football season, and subscribers were certainly happy he did: He proceeded to post a 55% success rate on NFL Best Bets in his "rookie" season. Gary finished strong in NFL Best Bets last season as well, going 67% ATS (16-8-2) after Week 9. He did the same thing in college basketball Best Bets with a 63% ATS mark (30-18) after Feb. 5 to finish with a 57% ATS record (64-49-2) in CBB Best Bets for the season. Gary is 71% (5-2) in NFL Totals this year, including a perfect 3-0 in Week 4 action.

StatFox Scott

StatFox Scott serves as Managing Editor for Stat-Fox, Platinum Sheet and the Edge Football Preview Guide. Scott really finished strong last season in NFL Best Bets, as he recorded a 59% ATS mark (33-23-2) after Week 3, and was outstanding on NFL totals all year at 56% (40-31), including a perfect 5-0 in the postseason games. His college basketball season also represented a huge finish, as Scott was 64% ATS (25-14-3) in college hoops Best Bets after Feb. 14. In the past two NFL weeks, Scott is 22-7 ATS (76%) in marguee grid games and 7-1 ATS in Best Bets.

StatFox Brian

A featured writer on Stat-Fox.com and for Platinum Sheet, StatFox Brian has yet to suffer a losing season of Platinum Sheet Best Bets in either college football or NFL since coming on board in 2010. Last year marked Brian's second straight 60% ATS (41-27-6) season record in NFL Best Bets, but it was his college basketball prowess that really stood out in 2013-14. Brian finished with a remarkable 69% ATS record (76-34-5) on CBB Best Bets for the season, a mark that including an eye-popping 77% ATS record (44-13-4) after Jan. 17. Brian is 10-2 in NFL Totals this season.

StatFox Forecaster

By weighing several key factors, including recent statistical averages, schedule strength and home-field advantage, the StatFox Forecaster has proven to be an extremely successful long-term handicapping tool. It's most accurate once a season is underway, as evident by winning records in all four sports' featured Platinum Sheet games last year. The Forecaster correctly predicted the ATS winner for 59% (149-105-12) of all NFL games, 57% (151-114-8) of all CFB games, 53% (207-181-12) of all NBA games and 51% (189-183-11) in college basketball last season.
