The Celtics will finally have all of their starters healthy to begin the season's second half. They have beaten the Cavs six out of eight times (5-3 ATS), and usually play well when the spread is small, going 5-2 (SU and ATS) in the past seven games with a spread of four points or less. Rajon Rondo is back from a two-game suspension and should be able to build on his impressive numbers versus Cleveland last season: 17.3 PPG, 65% FG, 10.3 APG and 3.1 Assist/TO ratio.

This spread is way too large for a team playing defense as well as New Orleans has recently. In the past six games (6-0 ATS), the Hornets have held opponents to 92.7 PPG on 41% FG (28% 3-pt FG). Although Chicago has won seven straight meetings, only two of those victories came by more than 14 points. The key to the Hornets (11-4 ATS as a road 'dog) keeping it close will be G Marco Belinelli, who has made 13-of-23 threes (57%) over his past five games.
