In the past 17 instances when the Lakers have been favored by 10 or more points, they are a 2-15 ATS. L.A. has also needed a lot of rest to be successful this year, as the team is 6-2 ATS with 2+ days of rest, but just 15-29-1 ATS (34%) with less than that. The Nets have been a much better bet on the road this season (15-12-1 ATS, 56%) than at home (8-17-1 ATS, 32%), and they had two full days of preparation. Plus, Lakers C Andrew Bynum is questionable (ankle).
