Dave is coming off a perfect week for NFL Best Bets, going 5-0 ATS in Week 3. That improves Dave to 60% ATS (9-6) for the season in NFL Best Bets. He was also 11-5 ATS (69%) in all of his CFB grid games during this past week.

StatFox Gary

StatFox Gary joined the StatFox and the Platinum Sheet staff prior to the 2010 football season. where he posted a 55% success rate on NFL Best Bets in his "rookie" season. Gary remained profitable in 2013 with a 67% ATS (16-8) success rate in NFL Best Bets after Week 9, and 57% ATS in CBB Best Bets. Last week, Garv was 2-1 ATS in CFB Best Bets, and was also 2-1 in his NFL Totals.

StatFox Scott

StatEox Scott serves as Managing Editor for StatFox, Platinum Sheet and the Edge Football Preview Guide, and known for strong finishes. Last vear. he was 59% ATS (33-23) in NFL Best Bets after Week 3, and was 56% (40-31) for yearly NFL Totals. He then went 64% ATS (25-14) in CBB Best Bets after Feb. 14. Scott had a perfect NFL Week 3. going 4-0 ATS in Best Bets and 3-0 in Totals.

StatFox Brian

A featured writer on Stat-Fox.com and for Platinum Sheet, StatFox Brian has vet to suffer a losing pro or college football season of Platinum Sheet Best Bets since coming on board in 2010. Last year he tallied a 60% ATS mark (41-27) in NFL Best Bets and insane 69% ATS record (76-34) in CBB Best Bets. Brian is 68% ATS (25-12-2) in NFL Best Bets since 11/25 and 9-0 in NFL Totals in 2014.

GAME BREAKDOWN: The Giants notched their first win of the season on Sunday, picking off Ryan Fitzpatrick three times on their way to a 30-17 home victory. The Redskins, meanwhile, lost in Philadelphia in a 37-34 shootout despite holding Philadelphia star running back LeSean McCoy to just 22 yards on 19 carries. The Redskins will again be led by quarterback Kirk Cousins, who threw for 427 yards against the Eagles. Since the start of last season, Washington is 4-1 ATS when Cousins has taken the majority of the snaps versus 3-10 ATS when Robert Griffin III has been at guarterback.

GAME BREAKDOWN: Tennessee enters this one off a 33-7 loss in Cincinnati on Sunday, as quarterback Jake Locker threw two interceptions in his second straight underwhelming performance. The Colts, meanwhile, won 44-17 in Jacksonville behind 370 yards and four touchdown passes from quarterback Andrew Luck. Expect the Indianapolis defense to try to put pressure on Locker in order to prevent him from getting comfortable like he did against Kansas City in Week 1. The Colts have won five straight (SU and ATS) versus the Titans, Tennessee QB Jake Locker (wrist) and Indianapolis WR T.Y. Hilton (ankle) are both questionable.

GAME BREAKDOWN: The Panthers lost 37-19 at home to the Steelers on Sunday night, setting a franchise low in rushing attempts with 10. Carolina's defense allowed Pittsburgh to rush for 264 yards, which was the third-highest total in Panther history. They'll go up against a Baltimore running game that has rushed for the eighth-most yards in the NFL through three games, thanks in part to rookie Lorenzo Taliaferro picking up 91 yards on 18 carries in Sunday's 23-21 win in Cleveland. Panthers RB DeAngelo Williams will likely play, while RB Jonathan Stewart (knee) and RB Mike Tolbert (leg) will not.

StatFox Dave

StatFox Gary

StatFox Dave is one of the original four founders of StatFox and over the vears has been renowned for his handicapping prowess in all sports. Dave was especially strong in the college sports last season, posting a 55% ATS mark (38-31-2) in 2013 CFB Best Bets. This included a hefty 77% ATS record (17-5-1) on college football games that were not part of the marquee games grid above. Dave then went on to nail 62% ATS (70-43-2) in college basketball Best Bets. Dave was a perfect 5-0 ATS in NFL Best Bets in Week 3, giving him a 60% ATS mark (9-6) this season.

StatFox Gary joined the StatFox and the Platinum Sheet staff prior to the 2010 football season, and subscribers were certainly happy he did: He proceeded to post a 55% success rate on NFL Best Bets in his "rookie" season. Gary finished strong in NFL Best Bets last season as well, going 67% ATS (16-8-2) after Week 9. He did the same thing in college basketball Best Bets with a 63% ATS mark (30-18) after Feb. 5 to finish with a 57% ATS record (64-49-2) in CBB Best Bets for the season. Gary was also 9-3-1 ATS (75%) in pre-October CFB Best Bets last season.

StatFox Scott

StatFox Scott serves as Managing Editor for StatFox, Platinum Sheet and the Edge Football Preview Guide. Scott really finished strong last season in NFL Best Bets, as he recorded a 59% ATS mark (33-23-2) after Week 3, and was outstanding on NFL totals all year at 56% (40-31), including a perfect 5-0 in the postseason games. His college basketball season also represented a huge finish, as Scott was 64% ATS (25-14-3) in college hoops Best Bets after Feb. 14. Scott is coming off a perfect NFL Week 3 in both Best Bets (4-0 ATS) and Totals (3-0).

StatFox Brian

A featured writer on Stat-Fox.com and for Platinum Sheet, StatFox Brian has yet to suffer a losing season of Platinum Sheet Best Bets in either college football or NFL since coming on board in 2010. Last year marked Brian's second straight 60% ATS (41-27-6) season record in NFL Best Bets, but it was his college basketball prowess that really stood out in 2013-14. Brian finished with a remarkable 69% ATS record (76-34-5) on CBB Best Bets for the season, a mark that including an eye-popping 77% ATS record (44-13-4) after Jan. 17. Brian is 9-0 in NFL Totals this year.

StatFox Forecaster

By weighing several key factors, including recent statistical averages, schedule strength and home-field advantage, the StatFox Forecaster has proven to be an extremely successful long-term handicapping tool. It's most accurate once a season is underway, as evident by winning records in all four sports' featured Platinum Sheet games last year. The Forecaster correctly predicted the ATS winner for 59% (149-105-12) of all NFL games, 57% (151-114-8) of all CFB games, 53% (207-181-12) of all NBA games and 51% (189-183-11) in college basketball last season.

The Bulldogs rolled up 822 yards of offense in that game, though this year's offense is completely rebuilt with QB Derek Carr gone and Brian Burrell and Brandon Connette splitting time in an ineffective passing game. Fresno did have 389 rushing yards in a 56-16 win over Southern Utah last week. The Lobos got their first SU win of 2014 last week, with a last-minute TD in a 38-35 win over New Mexico State.
