In that contest, the high-scoring Thunder duo of Kevin Durant and Russell Westbrook combined to shoot 10-of-35 FG while Clippers PG Chris Paul dominated (31 points, 11-of-20 FG). OKC has lost three straight road meetings (by 11.0 PPG) and the Clips are 15-5 ATS against great teams (+6.0 PPG margin) in the past two seasons.
