The Bucks are just too hot to pick against, especially with such a small spread against an erratic Celtics team that averages a mere 89.4 PPG on the road, where they are 8-13 (SU and ATS). Not only has Milwaukee won eight in a row ATS, but it also has averaged 113.3 PPG during a six-game SU win streak. The Bucks are 15-7-1 ATS (68%) with one day of rest, 13-6-1 ATS (68%) following an SU win, and 9-2 ATS in the past 11 meetings with Boston.
