The Blazers suffered an embarrassing 15-point home loss to lowly Washington Tuesday, allowing 124 points on 60% FG to the 7-22 Wizards. The Warriors have won the past four meetings by an average of 15.0 PPG, and they are 11-2-1 ATS (10-4 SU) in their past 14 games against the Blazers.
