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StatFox Dave

StatFox Dave is one of the original four founders of StatFox and over the years has been renowned for his handicapping prowess in all sports. Dave has been absolutely sizzling in his college football picks over the past four weeks, going **47-15-2 ATS (76%)** overall to boost his season win percentage to **68% (73-35-3 ATS)** for all featured Platinum Sheet games. He's also strong in college Best Bets (57%).

StatFox Brian

A featured writer on StatFox.com and for Platinum Sheet, StatFox Brian has yet to suffer a losing season of Platinum Sheet Best Bets in either college football, NFL, college basketball or NBA since coming on board in 2010. Brian has started the NFL season red-hot in both college and pro football, correctly picking **58% ATS (26-19)** Best Bets, including **13-7 ATS (65%) in NFL Best Bets**.

StatFox Scott

StatFox Scott serves as Managing Editor for StatFox, Platinum Sheet and the Edge Football Preview Guide, and is coming off two straight profitable college football seasons, winning a whopping 59% of his games ATS in 2010 followed by 53% ATS in 2011. Scott had a huge NFL Week 6, going 10-4 ATS (3-1 Best Bets) and **3-1 in Totals**. He boasts a hefty **13-6-1 Totals record (68.4%) this season**.

StatFox Gary

StatFox Gary joined the StatFox and the Platinum Sheet staff prior to the 2010 football season, and subscribers were certainly happy he did: He proceeded to post a 55% success rate on NFL Best Bets in his "rookie" season. Gary has been in a Best Bet zone lately, as he's currently on a 4-1 ATS run (**80%**) in college and 6-3 ATS run (**67%**) in the NFL.

GAME BREAKDOWN: The Niners have a chance to reassert their dominance over the NFC West. They've won 10 in a row SU at home versus division opponents (9-1 ATS), outscoring opponents 82-24 in three games under Jim Harbaugh a year ago. Both of these defenses have been outstanding early, though the red-hot 49ers offense was stumped by the Giants last week (as many points as interceptions: three). The Seahawks were held under 300 yards of offense in both meetings with San Francisco last year, but played the Niners close both times (San Fran covered at home thanks to two Ted Ginn return TDs in the final four minutes).

GAME BREAKDOWN: The Titans came to Buffalo last December and ran all over the Bills, with RB Chris Johnson going for 153 yards and two TDs on 23 carries. As a team, they had 187 and 6.0 YPC in a 23-17 win. The Bills have had trouble stopping the run again in 2012. Tennessee is coming off a more encouraging performance in beating the Steelers at home last Thursday, though they got a big boost from a blocked punt that led to a short TD. QB Matt Hasselbeck continues to be shaky under center (74.1 passer rating). The Bills are trying to find their way offensively, as they had only 306 yards of offense in last week's OT win in Arizona.

GAME BREAKDOWN: Robert Griffin III gets his first taste of an athletic Giants front that's coming off their best game of the season. Griffin has torched the defenses he's faced so far, including 182 passing yards, 138 rushing yards and three total TDs in a victory over the Vikings last week. The Giants' vaunted front four had struggled before dominating in San Francisco last week. The Giants recorded six sacks and intercepted Alex Smith three times while holding the Niners to three points. The Redskins swept the Giants last year, winning each game by two possessions.

GAME BREAKDOWN: The Bucs got their offense going a bit last week in blowing out Kansas City. Now they have a chance to do it again versus the Saints' porous defense. Josh Freeman threw for an impressive 328 yards and three TDs on only 15 completions, and the running game added 145 against K.C. The Saints had the bye week to get their house further in order. They suffered an upset loss at Tampa last year, 26-20, when they turned it over four times and allowed Freeman to throw for 303 yards. New Orleans had lost now-suspended head coach Sean Payton to a leg injury on the sideline during that loss.

Anyone who signed up for our NBA postseason Best Bets certainly knows that to be true, as Dave racked up an astounding 66% success rate on Best Bets during the NBA postseason. Dave has been unbelievable in his college picks over the past four weeks, going 47-15-2 ATS (76%) overall. He's also 57% ATS on his Best Bets, last week predicting, "NIU (-12) takes Buffalo to the woodshed in this easy cover." Northern Illinois won, 45-3.

StatFox Gary

StatFox Gary joined the StatFox and Platinum Sheet staff prior to the 2010 football season, and subscribers were certainly happy he did: He proceeded to post a 55% success rate on NFL Best Bets in his "rookie" season.
