The Blazers average only 90.7 PPG on the road with 41% FG shooting (28% 3-pt FG shooting), and four of their top six scorers shoot 40% or worse away from home. This trend should continue, as the Jazz limit visitors to 28.8% 3-pt FG. And even with two straight wins in Utah, the Blazers are still 4-16 SU (6-14 ATS) in their past 20 visits to Salt Lake City.
