#### StatFox Dave

StatFox Dave is one of the original four founders of StatFox and over the years has been renowned for his handicapping prowess in all sports. Dave has been in the zone in his college picks over the past three weeks, going 38-9-1 ATS (81%) overall and 14-8 ATS (64%) on his Best Bets. He predicted that Louisiana Tech (-24.5 vs. UNLV) would "cruise to 50 points" in an eventual 58-31 blowout victory.

#### StatFox Brian

A featured writer on Stat-Fox.com and for Platinum Sheet. StatFox Brian has yet to suffer a losing season of Platinum Sheet Best Bets in either college football, NFL, college basketball or NBA since coming on board in 2010. Brian has started the NFL season on fire, correctly picking 71% ATS (12-5) Best Bets, including 8-3 ATS (69%) over his past three weeks of NFL Best Bets.

#### StatFox Scott

StatFox Scott serves as Managing Editor for Stat-Fox, Platinum Sheet and the Edge Football Preview Guide, and is coming off two straight profitable college football seasons, winning a whopping 59% of his games ATS in 2010 followed by 53% ATS in 2011. Scott has been sizzling in NFL totals for the entire 2012 campaign. banging out an impressive 10-5-1 record (67%) this season.

#### StatFox Gary

StatFox Gary joined the StatFox and the Platinum Sheet staff prior to the 2010 football season, and subscribers were happy he did: He proceeded to post a 55% success rate on NFL Best Bets in his "rookie" season. Gary posted his fourth straight week of .500 ATS or better in both NFL overall and NFL Best Bets, and also went 3-1 in NFL Totals.

**GAME BREAKDOWN:** The Steelers are still dealing with injuries and haven't looked sharp on the road this year. Pittsburgh has dropped their two road games, SU and ATS, at Denver and Oakland. S Troy Polamalu (calf) is out again and OLB LaMarr Woodley (hamstring) is questionable at best. Neither offense has been sharp this year, though the Steelers got a boost from the return of RB Rashard Mendenhall (14 carries, 81 yards, TD against Philly). The Titans have really struggled, especially with back-up QB Matt Hasselbeck under center. RB Chris Johnson has struggled desperately in an anemic rushing attack.

Oakland is coming off a bye week after a disastrous start to the year. They've been outscored 72-19 in their two road games and sport arguably the worst secondary in the NFL. **GAME BREAKDOWN:** In Week 2 the Bengals held off the Browns in Cincinnati, 34-27 (an ATS push). The Browns actually outgained the Bengals in that game, 439-375, but allowed a punt return TD. Both teams are coming off disappointing games, with the Bengals showing no semblance of an offense outside of WR A.J. Green during a loss to Miami. Cleveland jumped out to a big lead on the road against the Giants, but couldn't hang on as QB Brandon Weeden threw two interceptions and Josh Cribbs lost a fumble on a kickoff return. They allowed 502 yards of offense, and could be without defensive leader LB D'Qwell Jackson (concussion) this week.

**GAME BREAKDOWN:** The Colts pulled off an unlikely upset at home, coming back to beat the Packers despite being without head coach Chuck Pagano (out a month for leukemia treatment). Rookie QB Andrew Luck wasn't efficient (31-for-55), but finished with 362 yards in the comeback win. Indy's rebuilding defense continues to hold its own (three straight weeks allowing less than 400 yards) and won't be threatened by a Jets offense that can't move the ball and is without its best player, WR Santonio Holmes (foot).

# Statfox super situations

Situational analysis uncovers conditions and patterns where teams have consistently outperformed or underperformed their normal levels. These systems are not team specific—the principle is that teams fall into patterns regardless of personnel (i.e. good passing teams, teams seeking revenge, cold teams on a losing streak, etc.).
