StatFox Brian

StatFox Brian has yet to suffer a losing season of Platinum Sheet Best Bets in either college football, NFL, college basketball or NBA since coming on board in 2010. He is coming off a typical banner week, going 3-0 ATS on his Best Bets for both college and NFL, including nailing both Monday night games. That gives Brian a combined football Best Bet Record of 8-1 ATS (89%) so far in 2012.

StatFox Dave

StatFox Dave is one of the original four founders of StatFox and over the years has been renowned for his handicapping prowess in all sports. Dave started his NFL season with a 4-2 ATS record in Best Bets, just missing a 5-1 mark by one-half point. He's also posted a 60% win percentage in college football Best Bets this season finishing the past week 4-2 for college.

StatFox Scott

StatFox Scott serves as Managing Editor for Stat-Fox, Platinum Sheet and the Edge Football Preview Guide, and is coming off back-to profitable college football seasons. He won a whopping 59% of his Best Bets in 2010 and 53% last year. He was 2-for-2 in Week 1 NFL Totals, playing two Overs based on no-huddle offenses (Falcons and Ravens) that each scored 40+ points to obliterate the total.

StatFox Gary

StatFox Gary joined the StatFox and the Platinum Sheet staff prior to the 2010 football season, and subscribers were certainly happy he did: He proceeded to post a 55% success rate on NFL Best Bets in his "rookie" season. Gary loves weeknight action in college football going 6-1 ATS (2-0 Best Bets) in games this season that occurred Monday through Friday on the national stage.

GAME BREAKDOWN: The Pack have beaten Chicago four in a row SU (3-1 ATS), and should be looking forward to this one after being smothered by San Francisco's elite defense last week. Chicago's offense looked good in a warmup opener against Indy, racking up 41 points and 428 yards of offense against a weak defense. The Packers defense has struggled over the past year, but the Bears have managed no more than 21 points in the teams' last five meetings while averaging 15.0 PPG. The Bears did manage to run for 199 yards and control the clock for 35:48 in their Christmas Day loss on the Tundra last season.

GAME BREAKDOWN: The Browns have dropped three in a row to the Bengals at home (0-3 ATS) and overall (1-2 ATS). And after watching rookie QB Brandon Weeden's disastrous debut, it's tough to see them snapping those streaks. Weeden was historically awful in his first start, going 12-for-35 for 118 yards and four INTs (a passer rating of 5.1), including 0-for-9 with three INTs on passes of more than 10 yards. He also fumbled twice (Cleveland recovered both). The Bengals didn't exactly light it up on Monday night against the Ravens, falling 44-13 to the team that appears to be the class of the AFC North this season.

GAME BREAKDOWN: Rookie QB Ryan Tannehill and the Dolphins should find things a little bit easier in start No. 2. The Dolphins did little against a very good Texans defense in Houston, as Tannehill threw three interceptions among Miami's four turnovers. The Raiders do have a solid pass rush, but can't match Houston's talent in the defensive backfield. Miami's defense, meanwhile, continues to play solid, and they'll have a chance to make some plays against erratic Oakland QB Carson Palmer. The Dolphins dominated Oakland last December, jumping out to a 34-0 lead before the Raiders scored two garbage time TDs.

GAME BREAKDOWN: Both teams were mistake-prone in Week 1, with the Bills turning it over four times against the Jets and the Chiefs three times against Atlanta. Buffalo is hoping this goes like their season-opening matchup in K.C. last year, when they destroyed the Chiefs 41-7 while holding K.C. to 213 yards of offense. Buffalo added a couple of marquee pass-rushers in Mario Williams and Mark Anderson, but neither were a factor against a suspect Jets offense, as Mark Sanchez completed 19-of-27 (70.4%) for 266 and three TDs, wasn't sacked and was rarely pressured. The Chiefs get their best player, OLB Tamba Hali, back from suspension.

GAME BREAKDOWN: Andrew Luck makes his first home start against a weak secondary after a decent afternoon on the road against a tough Chicago defense in his debut. He was intercepted three times but did throw for 309 yards. Minnesota barely scraped out a home win over Jacksonville in Week 1, getting an unlikely 55-yard field goal from rookie Blair Walsh at the end of regulation and going on to win in OT. RB Adrian Peterson proved to be closer to 100% than anyone expected (84 yards, 4.9 YPC, 2 TDs) and could have a big day against a Colts defense that's historically weak against the run and is adjusting to a new scheme.

After getting outgained by Western Michigan at home last week, Illinois is not in position to pull off a tough early road win."
