Dave started his NFL season with a 4-2 ATS record in Best Bets, just missing a 5-1 mark by one-half point. He's also posted a **60% win percentage in college football Best Bets** this season finishing the past week 4-2 for college.

StatFox Scott serves as Managing Editor for StatFox, Platinum Sheet and the Edge Football Preview Guide, and is coming off back-to-profitable college football seasons. GAME BREAKDOWN: The Browns have dropped three in a row to the Bengals at home (0-3 ATS) and overall (1-2 ATS). And after watching rookie QB Brandon Weeden's disastrous debut, it's tough to see them snapping those streaks. Weeden was historically awful in his first start, going 12-for-35 for 118 yards and four INTs (a passer rating of 5.1), including 0-for-9 with three INTs on passes of more than 10 yards. He also fumbled twice (Cleveland recovered both). The Bengals didn't exactly light it up on Monday night against the Ravens, falling 44-13 to the team that appears to be the class of the AFC North this season.

GAME BREAKDOWN: Rookie QB Ryan Tannehill and the Dolphins should find things a little bit easier in start No. 2. The Dolphins did little against a very good Texans defense in Houston, as Tannehill threw three interceptions among Miami's four turnovers. The Raiders do have a solid pass rush, but can't match Houston's talent in the defensive backfield. Miami's defense, meanwhile, continues to play solid, and they'll have a chance to make some plays against erratic Oakland QB Carson Palmer. The Dolphins dominated Oakland last December, jumping out to a 34-0 lead before the Raiders scored two garbage time TDs.

GAME BREAKDOWN: Both teams were mistake-prone in Week 1, with the Bills turning it over four times against the Jets and the Chiefs three times against Atlanta. Buffalo is hoping this goes like their season-opening matchup in K.C. last year, when they destroyed the Chiefs 41-7 while holding K.C. to 213 yards of offense. Buffalo added a couple of marquee pass-rushers in Mario Williams and Mark Anderson, but neither were a factor against a suspect Jets offense, as Mark Sanchez completed 19-of-27 (70.4%) for 266 and three TDs, wasn't sacked and was rarely pressured. The Chiefs get their best player, OLB Tamba Hali, back from suspension.

GAME BREAKDOWN: Andrew Luck makes his first home start against a weak secondary after a decent afternoon on the road against a tough Chicago defense in his debut. He was intercepted three times but did throw for 309 yards. Minnesota barely scraped out a home win over Jacksonville in Week 1, getting an unlikely 55-yard field goal from rookie Blair Walsh at the end of regulation and going on to win in OT. RB Adrian Peterson proved to be closer to 100% than anyone expected (84 yards, 4.9 YPC, 2 TDs) and could have a big day against a Colts defense that's historically weak against the run and is adjusting to a new scheme.

StatFox Dave caught fire in college football last week: He picked three home underdogs as Best Bets, all of which not only covered, but won their games outright despite the fact that all three were getting a touchdown or more. He picked Utah State on the strength of home underdogs of 3.5 to 10 points having been 11-4 ATS when coming off a season with a winning record; Dave rode Wake Forest on the fact that home underdogs of 3.5 to 10 points during the first two weeks of the year are 9-0 ATS over the last five seasons. He completed the trifecta with his pick of Oregon State.

StatFox Gary

StatFox Gary has a knack for college over/unders, finishing the bowl season 4-1 in his Best Bet totals. His big pick last week was Arizona State over Illinois, as Gary stated, "A year ago Arizona State beat USC and Missouri in September games in Tempe, and this year's squad should be better than last year's increasingly dysfunctional mess." After getting outgained by Western Michigan at home last week, Illinois is not in position to pull off a tough early road win." The Sun Devils, a four-point favorite, rolled to a 45-14 win that was never even remotely in doubt.

StatFox Scott

StatFox Scott serves as Managing Editor for StatFox and Platinum Sheet and the Edge Football Preview Guide, and is coming off a two-year college football run in which his Best Bets success rate was 56%. His big pick this past Saturday was underdog Florida at Texas A&M, a game the Gators won with Scott stating beforehand, "Texas A&M's scheduled season opener was postponed due to Hurricane Isaac, which puts the Aggies at a significant disadvantage when considering that they've got a new head coach as well as a new quarterback."

StatFox Brian

A featured writer on StatFox.com and for Platinum Sheet, StatFox Brian has yet to suffer a losing season of Platinum Sheet Best Bets in either college football, NFL, college basketball or NBA since coming on board in 2010. His most recent success earlier this calendar year was a 49-30 record (62%) against the spread on college basketball Best Bet picks. Brian was a perfect 3-for-3 in college football ATS Best Bets last week, upping his season mark to 5-1. He predicted LSU would win by 40 over Washington, which nearly came true in the Tigers' 41-3 blowout.

StatFox Forecaster

By weighing several key factors, including recent statistical averages, schedule strength and home-field advantage, the StatFox Forecaster has proven to be an extremely successful long-term handicapping tool. It's most accurate once a season is underway, as evident by an ATS success rate of 61% (123-79-6) on all 2011 NFL regular-season games played between September 25 and the end of the calendar year.
