Not only have the Nuggets been the best road bet in the NBA (15-5 ATS, 75%), but they are starting to get healthy and gear up for a strong finishing kick to the season. In the past two seasons, Denver is 23-7 ATS (77%) in road games after the All-Star break. Rookie Kenneth Faried and newly acquired JaVale Mc-Gee match up well with Utah's star interior players Al Jefferson and Paul Millsap, and the Nuggets are 12-6-2 ATS (67%) in the past 20 meetings with the Jazz.

Golden State certainly misses Monta Ellis, as the team has shot below 45% FG for five straight games without him (93.7 PPG, 42.7% FG). Meanwhile, the Kings' offense is rolling in the past five games (113.6 PPG on 49% FG).

Bettors have made a fortune choosing the Grizzlies in the second part of a back-to-back in the past two seasons, as Memphis is a ridiculous 25-6-1 ATS (81%) in that scenario. They are also 9-5 ATS when visiting the Lakers since 2004 and now they have Zach Randolph back healthy—he's averaged 12.0 RPG in the past nine meetings with Los Angeles. The Lakers are 4-7-1 ATS in March and 2-7 ATS when laying between 4.5 and 6.5 points this season.
