Utah is just 3-13 SU and 6-10 ATS on the road this year, and the team has lost six straight (2-4 ATS) outside of Salt Lake City. But over the past two seasons the Jazz have cruised past the Cavs three times (SU and ATS), including an 11-point win in Cleveland in Dec. 2010 and an eight-point win in Utah in January. Considering how poorly the Cavs are playing of late (five straight losses, 2-6 ATS in past eight contests), they're not a good bet to pull one out here.

The team is a strong 9-4 ATS (69%) when getting 9+ points this season. Portland has lost three of four home meetings in this series (SU and ATS), and is just 2-6 (SU and ATS) in its past eight home contests this season. The Blazers will win this game, but not by double digits.
