CIN: 15-1 UNDER away versus excellent offensive teams - averaging >=375 yards/game in the second half of the season since 1992....18-3 UNDER away vs. awful passing defenses - allowing a comp. pct. of 64% or worse in the second half of the season since 1992....7-0 UNDER after gaining 99 or less rushing yards in 2 straight games this season....13-4 ATS off 1 or more consecutive unders over the L2 seasons.

KC: 1-15 ATS after gaining 450 or more total yards/game over their last 3 games since 1992....11-3 OVER against conference opponents this season....8-1 OVER after covering the spread in 4 or 5 out of their last 6 games over the L2 seasons....6-0 OVER after having won 8 or more out of their last 10 games this season....10-25 ATS after gaining 375 or more total yards in 3 consecutive games since 1992.

Betting System: Any team against the total - excellent passing team (>=265 PY/G) against a poor passing defense (230-265 PY/G) after 8+ games, after allowing 8 or more passing yards/attempt in their last game. (31-6 Under) Play = Under the total

Series History - KANSAS CITY is 1-1 ATS (1-1 SU) vs. CINCINNATI. (1-0 ATS, 1-0 SU at home).

LAR: 8-0 UNDER at home after having won 2 out of their last 3 games over the L2 seasons....11-2 UNDER at home vs. poor passing defenses - allowing a comp. pct. of 61% or worse in the second half of the season over the L2 seasons....27-12 UNDER as a favorite over the L3 seasons...

Betting System: Any team where the total is between 42.5 and 49 points - a good offensive team (23-27 PPG) against an average defensive team (18-23 PPG) after 8+ games, after scoring 14 points or less last game. (27-4 Under) Play = Under the total

Series History – SAN FRANCISCO is 9-3 ATS (9-3 SU) vs. LA RAMS. (5-1 ATS, 5-1 SU away).
