Despite losing at home to L.A. last Wednesday, the Spurs are 14-2 SU (12-3-1 ATS) in their past 16 contests, crushing three straight opponents by 15.0 PPG and posting a +4.3 RPG margin. Although San Antonio played in Oakland on Monday night, no starter logged even 20 minutes of action, so fresh legs shouldn't be a problem. The Spurs are 28-15-2 ATS (65%) when favored this year, and the Lakers are a pathetic 2-10 ATS in their past dozen home games.
