The Cavs are on a 7-4-1 ATS run, showing that they will not quit. Memphis is 1-6 ATS in its past seven games, and 0-5 ATS when favored by double-digits this year, outscoring these opponents by a mere 3.8 PPG. The Grizzlies have beaten only one team by more than 13 points since March 10, a span of 26 games. Cleveland is 9-2 SU (8-3 ATS) in the past 11 meetings between these clubs, including 4-1 ATS (3-2 SU) in its past five trips to Memphis.
