Phoenix is in a bit of a funk with three straight losses, but the Suns usually get up for L.A., going 6-3 ATS in the past nine meetings. The Lakers are the best defensive team in the West, but they have nobody to contain Steve Nash. The Phoenix star is shooting 60% from the floor with 12.9 APG in his past seven games. And the Lakers struggle in the heavy favorite role, as they are 5-13 ATS (28%) in the past 18 instances they were giving at least eight points.

Atlanta is 6-0 (SU at ATS) in the past six meetings. But don't let the Hawks' 19-11 SU record make you think they are an elite NBA team. Atlanta is 2-6-1 ATS against the superior West, scoring only 88.0 PPG. Portland continues to shine on its home floor, going 10-6 ATS with 103.3 PPG on 46.4% FG. The Blazers are outscoring Rose Garden visitors by 10.6 PPG this year, thanks in part to Gerald Wallace making an impressive 57% of his shots from the floor at home.

Jeremy Lin-sanity reigns supreme, but the reason the Knicks will win this game will be the likely return of Carmelo Anthony. In the past two seasons, Anthony has averaged 28.0 PPG on 53% FG in the seven meetings with Dallas. Amar'e Stoudemire also dropped 28.5 PPG on the Mavs last season and no longer has to deal with elite defender Tyson Chandler, who is now his teammate. Chandler has as good a chance as any at limiting Mavs star Dirk Nowitzki.
